



William Henry Umland was born on March 3, 1945 in Brooklyn, NY. He attended Lutheran elementary school (skipped two grades), went to a Lutheran middle school and graduated from public high school. He continued his education at Cornell University, receiving an academic scholarship, then graduating with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Business Administration and Management.

In 1968 Bill was drafted into the Army (Signal Corps.) He was first stationed in Germany where he met Miss Ingrid Roehl, who would become his life-long love. They married in Germany in 1969. Their family increased with the birth of their first daughter, Carol Ann, born in Landstuhl, Germany in 1969.

Later, in 1969 Bill received orders to go to Vietnam, thus went to Cambodia (attached to Air Cavalry.) During that time, Ingrid and Carol Ann stayed with Ingrid's parents in Germany

In Cambodia, Bill was attached to a helicopter unit. On one mission, his helicopter was shot down. Bill suffered a severe ankle fracture but still managed to find his way to U.S. troops through the jungle, returned to the U.S. for treatment at Long Beach Naval Hospital. Only Bill and the co-pilot survived that crash. Bill received a Purple Heart & Bronze Star.

Bill was then assigned to Ft. Monmouth, NJ to attend officer's advanced courses. Following his courses he was assigned to Ft. Leonardwood, MO where Bill and Ingrid's second daughter, Joyce, was born in 1973.

Bill left active service as a Major and moved to Ontario, CA and then Alta Loma, CA where Carol Ann and Joyce grew up. After leaving active service, he signed up for the Army Reserve and spent 2 weeks annually in South Korea for joint exercises.

Bill ended up in working in real estate, specializing in escrow and opened his own escrow company in Chino, CA. In 2011 Bill and Ingrid moved to Beaumont CA where he began to specialize in foreclosures, and you guessed it, he opened his own foreclosure company. Bill officially retired in 2018 but continued working on foreclosures from home.
